Reviewed and discussed the past years School Improvement Plan:

Layton High school has seen a 17 percent increase in Language Arts scores and 22% increase in Math scores. The Administration feels that these score increases are due to the standards based grading that is showing student mastery and better understanding of concepts.

Various lunch groups with the counseling department Tues- Thurs. have shown to be beneficial for students.

Mike Moss reported on some of the goals and how they were met:

Layton High met their Math and Language arts goal and tied with their science scores. ACT Benchmarks show that Layton High is above the state average. We are also above the state average on AP testing. Layton High school has added and will be continuing to add more CE classes. The school gets a financial kickback for the CE classes that are taken and passed by our students.
