Discussion was held on upcoming Community Council Elections. Intent to run information will be sent out April 9<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> will be the time frame for parents to apply. April 19<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> will be the time frame to turn in and Ryck review applications. Elections will be held May 4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>. As of right now it looks like we will have 3 open spots needing to be filled.

Discussion was held on the upcoming student walkout in support of Parkland School victims and survivors. Guidelines are set and we are encouraging students and parents to download the SafeUT app. Brief discussion on how we could take this app and other videos to put towards the required school digital citizenship guidelines. Maybe we could show a quarterly video during parent teacher conferences when the counselors do other presentations.

Trustlands Money discussion on what we are able to approve. Some changes needed to be made per information Mr. Astle received since our last meeting. The drone for the Engineering Department is in pending status. It will cost \$1,000 a year for insurance, but it could possibly be covered by state risk management. Mr. Astle is awaiting more information before this is given the green flag.

The district will not be using Chromebooks but Webbooks instead. We can cut the \$5,000 from the English Department proposals and when the district brings in their Webbooks, the English department will be given the first ones.

The IVC lab will be taken off the table saving another \$32,000 from the proposed amount. Ryck will assess any left over money the school may have at the end of the year and use that instead. We will go ahead with a total of \$11,000 for the music department Marimba, Mr. Follet has about half of that from a purchase he was going to make last year but decided the Marimba was a better purchase for the program at this time. The sound shell is also a go.

At this time all other funds were approved. See February council minutes to see all proposed amounts. Council will meet again in April for final approval and signatures.
