

REGISTRATION FOR YOUR JUNIOR YEAR

Step 1 Select Your English

AP English Language OR English 11 Honors OR English 11

Step 2 Select Your US History (found under Social Studies)

AP US History OR CE US History OR US History II

Step 3 Select Your Math

All students need to take at least Sec Math I and Sec Math II. The state recommends Sec Math III, but there are other choices. Talk with your math teacher for recommendations. Before the end of the year, the math teachers will send recommendations to the counselors. A form will be made available if you would want to take a math class other than the recommended class. Ex: Accounting 1 & 2 or Math of Decision Making

Step 4 Select Your Science

AP Physics, CE Physics, Physics Honors, Physics, CE Chemistry, Chemistry, AP Biology, Biology

You cannot repeat a science class unless you are going from a regular to an AP course.

IF you have taken two traditional classes from the above selections (9th Grade Earth Systems counts also), you may select your third credit for science to be from the following choices: Animal Science, Astronomy, Introduction to Engineering Design, Medical Anatomy & Physiological Science (MAPS), Meteorology, Principles of Engineering, Zoology

NOTES:

For the Regent's scholarship, you will need to take a version of Biology, Chemistry and Physics. You must complete the entire course. For example, you can't move from Biology Honors to Biology and still qualify for Regent's.

CE Physics **will not** satisfy Regent's scholarship requirements.

University of Utah and many out-of-state schools require two lab sciences which come from the subjects: physics, biology and chemistry.

Step 5 Select Your Financial Literacy

Financial Literacy (semester) OR Adult Roles & Financial Literacy (full year)

Either class meets the graduation requirement. You need to complete all of Adult Roles to meet the state requirement. There is a CE Adult Roles or regular Adult Roles choice.

Step 6 Check Your Graduation Summary

You have access to your graduation summary through mydsd under the reports tab.

Do you need to take health, fit for life, fine arts or computer tech? If so, don't forget them.

Digital Studies will be the new title for the Computer Tech category. You need ONE from the category, but more can be taken for elective credit. The choices are Computer Tech, Computer Tech II, Digital Business Applications, Exploring Computer Science or Web Development

Frequently Asked Question's

Why can't I request TA/ Office Assistant now?

If the class requires a contract to be signed like TA, then you can't sign up for the class until the contract is completed. TA contracts aren't available until August for 1st semester and December for 2nd semester. You will have to come in during class change time or the first week of school to have credits and citizenship verified BEFORE those can be added to your schedule. If these are the reasons you are changing your schedule, the schedule change is no cost. Teachers aren't available for signatures on the contract until the week before school at the earliest. TA contracts can also be completed the first week of school.

What if I change my mind on my course requests?

The course requests online screen will be open until February 28th for you to make changes. You can even change your requests from home until the online screen is closed. After that, you will have to come and see your counselor before or after school or during lunch to make any changes.

What if I am trying out for a group?

If you plan on trying out for a group or team, you will need to complete an online Form to let counselors know: What group you are trying out for, which classes will you remove from your schedule to add the new class, etc. When you make the group or team you are trying out for and it includes a required class, you need to see your counselor right away to get that changed. Changes because of try-outs are free of charge.



What if I am interested in going to the Davis Technical College or Catalyst Center?

If you are interested in doing a program at the DTC, please let your counselor know. You can put the course #701 "DTC placeholder" on your course request. Please add it for a minimum of 2 periods (DTC classes are typically double block periods).

If you are interested in attending the Catalyst Center, please let your counselor know and complete the following questions on the QR code. That will allow your counselor to know your interests and which classes you want to drop to fit it in your schedule. Catalyst Classes are also double block periods. What if I want to take online classes through Davis Connect?

If you were wanting to take online classes through Davis Connect, please submit the following form. This will let counselors know you want to do online classes. Counselors will reach out to students who submitted the form and gather any other important information before registering for the class.

What if I want home release?

You cannot enter a home release on your course requests. Please fill out all 8 classes in both columns as well as 3 alternatives, then complete the QR code and answer the questions. We included the home release form on our website and on canvas in the "Counseling Resources" course. You must submit the completed form to your counselor who will review your credits. If everything is still in line for graduation, the counselor will add it to your course requests. **You will NOT qualify for an honors award at graduation if you take less than 7 classes each semester of your 10th and 11th grade school year.**
