HB 144 Non-Resident Tuition Exemption

Students not eligible for residency due to immigration status may qualify for an exemption from non-resident tuition under the HB 144 waiver. In order to qualify for the HB 144 waiver, students must have attended a Utah high school for at least three years and have earned a Utah high school diploma or GED.
