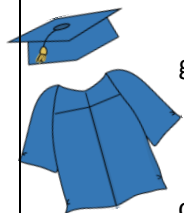

All Utah colleges and universities accept the ACT.

If you are planning on going out of state, check the admissions requirements of the school you plan on attending to see if they require the ACT or SAT, or if the writing portion of the ACT is mandatory.

OCTOBER 10TH WILL BE TEST DAY AT LAYTON HIGH SCHOOL

We are pleased to announce a great opportunity for ALL of our students at Layton High School. On October 10th, students will have an opportunity to take one of the tests listed below. If you are going to take the practice ACT, there is no extra step; a test has been ordered. If you are going to take the ASVAB, you must sign up for it in the counseling center.

Test	What is it?	Grades/Requirements
Practice ACT	This test is an ACT practice test to prepare for the ACT. Students will receive a detailed score report and have access to video explanations for all questions. This is a new version from last year, so it will be helpful for all grades. This is perfect timing to prepare for both the October and December ACT.	All grades are welcome to take this. Most students will be taking this test. Students are automatically assigned this test if they don't sign up for a different test.
ASVAB	This is a vocational aptitude test that provides great insight into which careers an individual is naturally matched. This is great for those seniors who are done with the ACT, but do not know what they want to study in college.	12 th Graders Students must sign up for this FREE test in the counseling office by October 3rd.

- Test Room assignments will be posted on the counseling center window on October 9th.
- You will need a pencil and calculator.
- You will report to your assigned test rooms at 7:30 am like a regular school day. Though times will vary, testing should be finished around 12:10 pm.
- Lunch will be served like a regular school day, but there will be no formal classes.
- Following lunch, teachers will be available for consultation.
- Buses will follow their regularly scheduled times

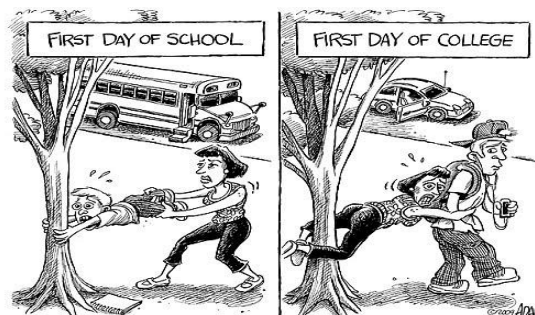
