

Davis Community School Scouts BSA Online Merit Badge Camp

Welcome to the Scouts BSA Online Merit Badge Camp. The purpose of the program is to give Scouts an opportunity to work on their merit badge advancement online under the direction of a Youth Protection certified Scouts BSA merit badge counselor. All merit badges are taught online using the educational platform Canvas and are open to all boys and girls involved in the Scouting program. All sessions are \$99 per Scout and last two months OR the individual merit badge classes are \$45 each.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

- 1. Register and pay on-line by visiting <u>https://www.signmeup.com/BSAMB</u>.
- 2. In-person registration and payment are available only in the Layton (UT) High School main office during regular school hours (7:30 am-2:30 pm).
- 3. Mail-in registration and payment is available by completing the sign-up form and mailing it to David Hopkins C/O Layton High School 440 Wasatch Dr. Layton, UT 84041. **Make all checks payable to LHS.**
- 4. Each registration and payment per Scout are only good for that session. Scouts will lose access to all merit badges at midnight MST on the last day of each session. Scouts will need to register and pay for the individual merit badge or new session to continue working on what they did not finish during the previous session.
- 5. Once a Scout registers and pays **no refunds** will be granted except in the case of a medical emergency and only with an accompanying doctor's note. Please contact David Hopkins at <u>dhopkins@dsdmail.net</u> if this situation should arise.
- 6. Registration and payment cannot be moved from one session to another.

STEPS OF THE PROGRAM

To register your Scout for the Scouts BSA merit badge online camp do the following:

- 1. Go to <u>www.signmeup.com/BSAMB</u> and register your Scout.
- 2. Choose the session you want the Scout enrolled in OR you can enroll your Scout in individual classes.
- 3. Choose the merit badges your Scout will work on during the session.
- 4. Go to check-out, agree to the wavier/release policy, and then make payment. Upon payment a receipt will be emailed to you.
- 5. Within 24 hours the Scout will be entered by their merit counselor (Adam Sturm <u>adsturm@dsdmail.net</u>) into a free educational learning platform called Canvas. Scouts will work within Canvas to earn the merit badge. Within this platform they will communicate with the teacher, complete merit badge requirements lessons, and turn in completed work.
- 6. A welcome letter will be emailed to the Scout and their parent granting them access to the online merit badge camp, explaining the rules and expectations of the class, and how to access online platform Canvas.
- 7. This is a self-paced course in which Scouts can work on and complete any merit badge offered during the session.
- 8. When the Scout completes all requirements for a merit badge class, they will submit their work to the counselor via Canvas. The counselor will check over the work and



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communicate with the Scout and their parents that they earned the blue card or need to do more work.

- 9. All completed blue cards will be mailed at the end of the session to the address provided by the Scouts' parent when they registered for the session.
- 10. If the Scout does not complete a merit badge within the time restraints of each session they will need to register and pay for another session to be able continue working on it. They would also be free to work on merit badges they still need to earn during that session.
